You need to open up and show Mr. Bigler who you truly are and what you aspire to be. Whether you are chosen to participate in the office you apply for is not the point. Dig deep inside, answer the questions, and complete the service project with the intent of learning something new. Please do not fill out this application unless you are prepared to participate in the leadership training process.

Failure to do so will result in the return of the application to the applicant.

- 1. Please provide a resume. Be sure to highlight your past leadership roles and experiences.
- 2. On a separate piece of paper, please answer the following questions:
  - a. What are your greatest personal strengths and how would the program benefit from them?
  - b. What are some areas in which our organization could improve?
  - c. What is something you are willing to commit to doing better as a member of the program?
- 3. Interview someone on campus (faculty, or administrator) and ask him or her their views on leadership. What did you learn from your conversation? How were his/her views different from your own?

#### **Complete the following projects:**

- Complete a service project for the organization. The scope and duration of the project are at your discretion. You may choose something that you think needs to be done, or you may ask Mr. Bigler for a project. If you have any questions about the validity of your chosen project, please speak with Mr. Bigler prior to starting it.
- 2. Do something that dazzles us! This is where you have the opportunity to do something that shows your creative side. You may do anything that you deem appropriate to convince us that you are able to "think outside the box" and show us your passion for music. This is the portion of the application where you should expect to invest the most time and show us something uniquely impressive about you. Therefore, take a risk here. Once again, this should be fun for you and the organization.

Example:

- Set up a zoom call with a composer for the program
- Create a coloring book from pictures of the orchestra & choir to give to a children shelter

Please understand that if chosen, you will be held to a higher standard of behavior, performance, and work ethic than your peers. You must be willing to make that sacrifice so that others around you may succeed. Serving in this capacity will not only provide others with a better experience but will provide you with a tremendous growth opportunity that will serve you for years to come.
